The Michigan Transfer Agreement (MTA) was designed to facilitate the transfer of general education courses from a community college to a 4-year college or university in Michigan. To fulfill the Michigan Transfer Agreement, students must successfully complete at least 30 credits with at least a 2.0 in each course. Students must also complete at least one credit-bearing course at WCC.

To determine if you qualify for the Michigan Transfer Agreement (MTA), log into MyWCC to run a DegreeWorks audit. Select the **What-If** tool located on the left. In the drop down list for degree select **certificate**, and select **Liberal Arts-MTA** for major. Click **Process What-If** to see your audit.
